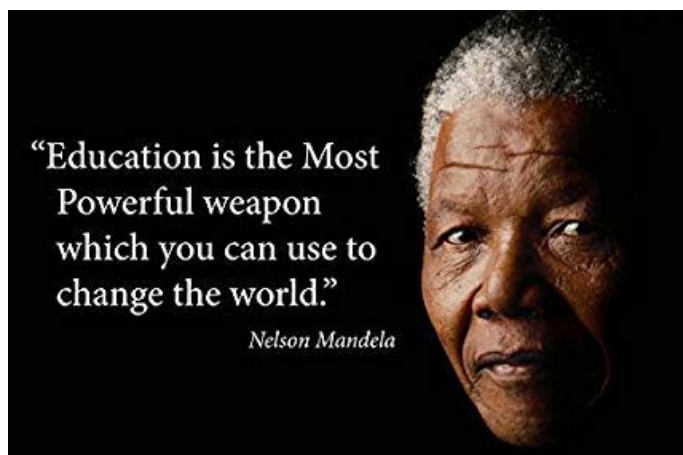
NAPLAN for our school has been finalised for 2019 and our students participated well without any difficulties. Reports will be sent home to families later in the year.
